**THE THREE RIVERS (GIBBS COUCH & DELTA GAIN, CARPENDERS PARK)
(RESTRICTION & PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND PARKING) ORDER 2009**

Dear Mr. Kerr,

Bond Pearce LLP at 3, Temple Quay, Temple Back East, Bristol, BS1 6DZ conducted a very restricted consultation on behalf of the Council between 20th February and today about the Council's above Order. Since the Council's proposed changes could affect residents throughout Carpenders Park we notified all residents about the proposals and told them that they could write to the Director of Community & Environmental Service by 20th March; let us have their views to forward to the Council and sign a Petition to: 1. DEPLORE the lack of information on the proposed changes, 2. INSIST all Carpenders Park Residents be fully informed of parking proposals relating to our shops and our station and 3. DEMAND a Public Exhibition and Consultation, staffed by Council Officers, at the Carpenders Park Community Hall.


- 1) Twenty three Petition Forms with a total of 296 signatures

In view of the widespread concern about the Council's proposals I hope the Council will re-think them and before any decisions are taken Council Officers will provide a Public Exhibition in the Community Hall, in Carpenders Park. There is great concern that if the present proposals went ahead commuters would park in adjacent streets and in the car park at the back of the shops in The Parade, Delta Gain. Has the Council consulted the owner of that car park about the implications of the proposals? If not, I urge the Council to do so.

Please give all the enclosures to the Committee that will be considering responses to the Council's proposals and acknowledge receipt of the enclosures.
