Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

1. No supply of alcohol shall be made under this Premises Licence at a time:
 - (a) when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the Premises Licence.
 - (b) when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his or her personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the Premises Licence shall be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
3. When one or more individuals are required to carry out security activity such as door supervision, each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e):

- There will be strong management controls and effective training so that all staff are aware of the licensing objectives and in particular ensure :-
 - No under age drinking
 - Drunkenness on the premises
 - Drunkenness in public
 - Use of drugs
 - Violent and anti social behaviour
 - Protection of children from harm

b) The prevention of crime and disorder:

- There will be responsible management of the premises
- Keeping of capacity levels
- There will be training for all staff and strict supervision
- Best practice guides e.g. the National Alcohol Harm Reduction Strategy Tool Kit and other voluntary codes of practice, will be adopted.
- There will be use of “proof of age” schemes
- To join a local Pub Watch when available.
- Glasses made from toughened glass will be used indoors and plastic outdoors.
- Secure deposit boxes will be provided for confiscated items.
- Litterbins will be provided around the site.
- Outside lighting to be installed/maintained outside the premises
- CCTV

c) Public safety:

- The risk management assessment will be checked weekly.
- There will be effective and responsible management control in at all times.
- The use of SIA registered door staff and maximum staff levels, to secure safety of the premises and customers.
- There will be on going training and supervision of all those employed, with regular fire drills and good management control.
- There will be regular testing and certification of all procedures and appliance.

d) The prevention of public nuisance:

- There will be responsible management at all times
- There will be training and supervision to prevent incidents of public nuisance
- There will be regular patrolling of the premises, including the exterior.
- There will be supervision and control of any queues forming and door search procedure.
- There will be control of deliveries and bottling up.
- There will be management of people entering and leaving the premises, cloak room control and notices to all requesting to all to "Please leave quietly"
- Only licensed mini-cabs will be used
- There will be external lighting and external CCTV on 24 hour recording with a 31 day rotation of tapes.

e) The protection of children from harm:

- Sufficient staff with the appropriate training, will be provided to secure the protection of children from harm
- The best practice guide "Public Places Charter" will be adopted
- Children will only be allowed on the premises between 10:00 and 20:00 hours, except in the dining room when they can stay until 23:00 hours.
- No children allowed in the bar areas during entertainment
- Children must be accompanied by an adult in the restaurant, which will be controlled by the supervisor at the time.
- A proof of age scheme and/or photo ID driving licences will be used.

Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

The amended application to vary this existing Premises Licence was granted on 19 June 2006 by the Licensing Committee in the following terms:

1. To permit the hours for supply of alcohol as follows;

Monday to Thursday	10:00 to 23:00 hours
Friday and Saturday	10:00 to 23:30 hours
Sunday	10:00 to 23:00 hours,

with an additional 30 minutes drinking up time, every day.

2. To permit Late Night Refreshment on Friday and Saturday from 23:00 to 23:30 hours.
3. To permit live and recorded music within the pub building only and within the hours for the supply of alcohol.

With the following Conditions:

4. All doors and windows to be kept shut except for the entry and exit of customers, during the performance of live and recorded music at the premises and that the perimeter of the building will be monitored for noise during such performances.
5. Bar in Beer Garden to close at 23:00 on Friday and Saturday.
