Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

a) General – all four licensing objectives: (b,c,d,e)

- The premises will be run as a pizza take away and delivery service only.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder:

- There will be CCTV in the shop (see Annex 3)
- Customers will be encouraged to not loiter outside the shop premises

c) Public safety:

- Customers shall not stay on the premises longer than is required.
- Electrical and gas equipment shall be checked and serviced every 12 months.

d) The prevention of public nuisance:

- Notices requesting customers to respect the neighbours and other patrons in the area.
- The litter bins outside the premises shall be maintained.
- Large groups of customers shall not be allowed to remain on the premises.

e) The protection of children from harm:

- There will be no gaming machines on the premises.
- Alcohol will not be sold on the premises.

Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

The Premises: Farmhouse Pizza, 188b Watford Road, Croxley Green, WD3 3DB

**At the hearing the applicant amended the hours being sought for late night refreshment .
Application to read as follows :-**

To permit the supply of late night refreshment (hot food and hot drinks) for the following times:

Monday to Thursday from 23.00 to 23:30 hours

Friday and Saturday from 23.00 to 00:30 hours

No late night refreshment on Sunday as premises to close at 23:00 hours

Decision

After taking into consideration all the written representations and evidence, and the evidence given at the hearing, the Committee decided to grant the amended application subject to the following Conditions:

1. CCTV is to be installed to Police specifications and to be kept in good working order.
2. Prominent, clear and legible notices to be displayed stating :-

There be no loitering allowed
To respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly
That CCTV is in operation
The Opening and Closing Times of the Premises
3. Another litter bin must be installed in the premises.
4. Litter dropped by customers to be cleared from the immediate vicinity of the premises.

Reasons for Decision

The Committee decided to impose the Conditions (offered by the applicant at the hearing) on the Licence as they related to matters within the control of the applicant, were relevant to the application and premises, were reasonable in their content and were justified on the grounds of prevention of public nuisance and crime and disorder and in order to protect residents' rights to peace and quiet late at night.

Informative (not forming part of the decision on the application)

The granting of this licence does not confer any Planning Permission for the hours granted and a planning application will have to be made.
