

# LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

## Three Rivers District Council

### (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2019

Made 28<sup>th</sup> March 2019

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

Electoral arrangements for the parish of Abbots Langley were provided for in the Hertfordshire (Electoral Changes) Order 2015.

Three Rivers District Council (“the Council”), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (“the 2007 Act”), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated 26 February 2019 to make changes to the parish electoral arrangements for Abbots Langley parish.

The Council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons, and had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The Council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section.

The Council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86, 98(3) and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

The Local Government Boundary Commission has given its consent to the changes.

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Three Rivers District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2019.
- (2) It shall come into force on 1 April 2019
- (3) Article 4 shall come into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2019.

## Interpretation

2. In this order-

“district” means the district of Three Rivers;

“map” means the map marked “Map” referred to in the Three Rivers District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2019” and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act; and any reference to a numbered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that number;

“ordinary day of election of councillors” has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983; and

“registration officer” means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8(c) of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

## Effect of Order

3. This order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this order.

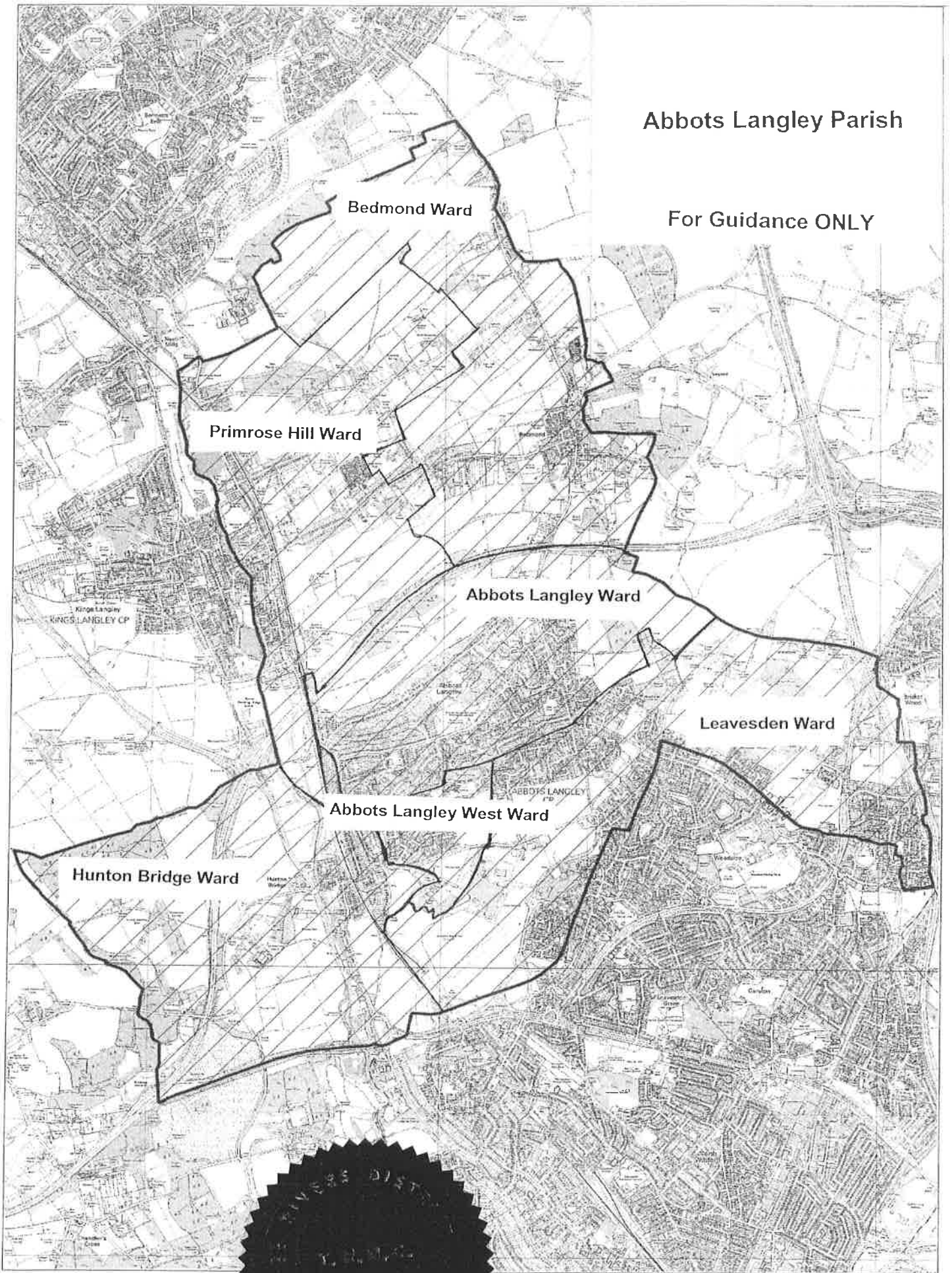
## Wards of the parish of Abbots Langley and numbers of parish councillors

4. (1) The parish of Abbots Langley shall be divided into six wards each listed by name in column 1 of the table below, and the number of councillors to be elected for each ward shall be as set out in column 2 in the table below:

Column (1)	Column (2)

Abbots Langley West	2
Bedmond	1
Hunton Bridge	1
Leavesden	5
Primrose Hill	2

- (3) Each Ward shall comprise the area designated on the map by reference to the name of the parish ward.

### **Electoral register**



### **Order date**

6. 1 April 2019 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Council) (England) Regulations 2008.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the order)

This order gives effect to recommendations made by Three Rivers District Council for the alteration of the area of the parish of Abbots Langley within the district of Three Rivers and supersedes changes provided by The Hertfordshire (Electoral Changes) Order 2015.

The parish of Abbots Langley will be altered with effect from 1 April 2019. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2019.

Article 5 obliges the Electoral Registration Officer to make any necessary amendments to the electoral register to reflect the new electoral arrangements.

The map identified in article 4 shows the new wards of the parish of Abbots Langley. It is available, at all reasonable times, at the offices of Three Rivers District Council.
