

Terms and conditions for the issue of permits and or visitors vouchers.

Declaration to be accepted by all applicants.

I understand that any physical permit or visitor voucher/s issued to me must be returned to the council immediately if :

- i) If I cease to be a permanent resident at the address for which the permit was issued, within the Controlled Parking Zone as defined in the Traffic Regulation order governing the scheme.
- ii) Any vehicle specified on the application is adapted or used in such a way that it ceases to be a passenger carrying vehicle, dual purpose vehicle, goods vehicle or motor cycle defined in the Traffic Regulation Order governing the scheme.
- iii) The vehicle in question does not exceed 5.25m in length and 2.3m height.
- iv) I am issued with a replacement permit.
- v) Payment made for the purchase of the permit or visitors vouchers is dishonoured.
- vi) Any permit or visitor voucher is found to be resold or fraudulently used.
- vii) Information relating to the issue of the permit or vouchers transpires to be false.
- viii) The council notifies me that the permit has been cancelled because one of the grounds specified above has occurred.

Parking permits and visitors vouchers do not :-

- Guarantee a parking space
- Allow parking on single or double yellow lines.
- Allow obstruction of vehicular/pedestrian access points and or driveways.
- Allow parking where suspensions are in place.

By ticking the accept terms and conditions box I declare that all of the information given in the application for permit/vouchers is correct and understand that any false statement or breach of the above my result in the withdrawal of my permit/vouchers and render me liable for prosecution.
