Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:
 - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
3. (1) The premises licence holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
(2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.
4. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
5. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 4 —
 - (a) “duty” is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979;
 - (b) “permitted price” is the price found by applying the formula —
$$P=D+(D \times V)$$
where —
 - (i) P is the permitted price,
 - (ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
 - (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the VAT were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
 - (c) “relevant person” means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence —
 - (i) the holder of the premises licence,
 - (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
 - (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;
 - (d) “relevant person” means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and
 - (e) “value added tax” (VAT) means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.
6. Where the permitted price given by sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph 5 would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.
7. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph 5 on a day (“the first day”) would be different from the permitted price on the next day (“the second day”) as a result of a change to the rate of duty or VAT.
(2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

1. CCTV shall be installed and provide general views of the interior of the premises and cover all entrances and exits. CCTV shall be retained for a minimum of 31 days. The CCTV shall have a recording and downloading facility.
2. Notices shall be displayed at the bar area advising customers that no alcohol sales are permitted between 07.00hrs and 11.00hrs.
3. Alcohol will be ancillary to those customers taking a table meal.
4. Alcohol will only be served to customers by waiter/waitress service.
5. There will be half an hour "drinking up" time each day between 22.30hrs and 23.00hrs.
6. Signage shall be displayed in the restaurant area requesting customers to respect local residents by leaving the premises quietly.
7. The placing of waste including bottles into receptacles outside the premises shall only take place between 07.00hrs and 23.00hrs to minimise disturbance to nearby properties.
8. A Challenge 21 policy shall be adopted.
9. All staff that serves alcohol shall be trained in the Challenge 21 scheme or similar recognised UK age verification policy.
