## **Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions**

1. A club premises certificate may not authorise the supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises unless it also authorises the supply of alcohol to a member of the club for consumption on the premises.
2. A club premises certificate which authorises the supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises must include the following conditions.
  - a. the supply must be made at a time when the premises are open for the purposes of supplying alcohol, in accordance with the club premises certificate, to members of the club for consumption on the premises.
  - b. any alcohol supplied for consumption off the premises must be in a sealed container.
  - c. any supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises must be made to a member of the club in person.
3. (1)The responsible person must ensure that staff on the premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises, and the responsible person is any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables him to prevent the supply in question.
4. In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises—
  - a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to—
    - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
    - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
  - b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
  - c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
  - d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner;
  - e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of disability).
5. The responsible person who is any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables him to prevent the supply in question, must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
6. The responsible person who is any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables him to prevent the supply in question, must ensure that—

a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures—

- (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
- (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
- (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml;

b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and

c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.”

### **Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Club Operating Schedule**

1. All members of the Pavilion Bowls Club will be vetted by committee before being allowed membership
2. All doors and main windows shall be shuttered and secured with appropriate padlocks
3. A low level of alcohol shall be kept at the clubhouse at any one time
4. All monies shall be removed from the club house.
5. The bar area shall be locked outside of licensable hours
6. There shall be an external lighting arrangement at the premises
7. There shall be security cameras at the premises
8. Access to the club shall be by membership only
9. Alcohol shall only be available when the designated barman or a committee member of the Pavilion Bowls is present.
10. The club premises must not be used by anyone other than the members of the Pavilion Bowls Club and members of other bowls clubs and immediate family of members.
11. Consideration shall be given to the neighbours at all times.
12. All children visiting the Pavilion Bowls Club shall be under parental control at all times. Persons under the age of 18 shall not be allowed to purchase or consume alcohol at any time.
