Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

1. No supply of alcohol shall be made under this Premises Licence at a time:
 - (a) when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the Premises Licence.
 - (b) when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his or her personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the Premises Licence shall be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
3. (1) The premises licence holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
(2) The policy must require individuals, who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy), to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e):

- None

b) The prevention of crime and disorder:

- The premises will have an intruder alarm, which must be maintained in working order.
- The premises licence holder will install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system to the satisfaction of Hertfordshire Police.
- There will be a CCTV camera covering the entrance to the premises to enable frontal identification in any light condition, of persons entering the premises.
- The CCTV system shall continuously record whilst the premises is open for licensable activities and all recordings shall be stored for a minimum of 31 days and will have date and time stamping.
- All recordings shall be made available immediately upon the request of Police or Authorised Officers.
- A member of staff conversant with the operation of the CCTV system, shall be on the premises at all times when the premises is open to the public and shall be able to show Police or other Authorised Officers recent DATA or footage when requested, with minimum delay.
- All staff engaged in the sale or supply of alcohol at the premises will be either, 1) the holder of a personal licence or 2) trained to the minimum standard provided for in the Level 1 Award in Responsible Alcohol Retailing (ARAR).
- A record of staff training shall be maintained and made available, on request, to Police and the Licensing Authority.
- Spirits offered for sale, must not be available on a self service basis.
- It will not be permitted to take drinks off the premises in an open container.
- A record of all refusals must be maintained in a refusals log, which must be produced on request to a Police Officer or other Authorised Officer.

c) Public safety:

- To ensure the safety of customers and staff risk assessments required under separate legislation will be maintained and regularly updated.

d) The prevention of public nuisance:

- No alterations will be made to the external air conditioning plant without planning consent.
- Risk assessments relating to noise/vibrations from internal equipment will be carried out, to ensure that such equipment is inaudible in any adjacent properties.

e) The protection of children from harm:

- The premises will have a mandatory age verification policy in place; any person who does not appear to be 21 years of age will be required to produce ID such as a Passport, Photographic Driving Licence or an ID card displaying the 'PASS' hologram logo.
- Clearly visible 'Age Check' signage will be displayed at the entrance and point of sale.
