Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

1. No supply of alcohol shall be made under this Premises Licence at a time:
 - (a) when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the Premises Licence.
 - (b) when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his or her personal licence is suspended.
2. Every supply of alcohol under the Premises Licence shall be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
3. Observance of BBFC age classification for the showing of films and videos.
4. (1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
 - (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children—
 - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to—
 - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
 - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);
 - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;
 - (d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on—
 - (i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
 - (ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;
 - (e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.
5. The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
6. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
7. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

- (2) The policy must require individuals, who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy), to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.
8. The responsible person shall ensure that–
- (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures–
- (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
 - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
- (b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e):

- All members must vacate the clubhouse no later than the published time for closing or, otherwise immediately the bar closes.
- Subject to any restrictions, which may from time to time be imposed by the general committee, the following persons shall be entitled to admission to the club premises and to be supplied with and/or sold alcohol; for consumption on the premises and shall for all purposes be regarded as guests of the club and its members:
 1. Golfers on payment of the appropriate green fee and members guests
 2. Those taking table meals at the club
 3. Those attending any function organised at the club.
- Anyone who looks under 21 years of age will be challenged to prove their age by producing one of the following items of proof:
 - i. Passport
 - ii. Driving licence
 - iii. National Proof of Age Standard Scheme (PASS) card

b) The prevention of crime and disorder:

- CCTV cameras will be in operation inside and outside the premises; recordings will be available to the Police and Licensing Authorities on request.
- No person who appears to be intoxicated will be served alcohol.

c) Public safety:

- See paragraphs a) and b).

d) The prevention of public nuisance:

- See paragraphs a) and b) above.
- Controls will be put in place to ensure that noise levels do not cause a nuisance to neighbours. These will include closing windows and doors during live performances and the use of noise limiters to maintain a level of less than 90 decibels.

e) The protection of children from harm:

- As in paragraph a).
- The restrictions set out in the Licensing Act 2003 will apply.

Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

The Premises: Sandy Lodge Golf Club, Sandy Lodge Lane.
Determined: 8th October 2013

Decision:

After considering the amended application, the written representations, the oral submissions of the Applicant's representative, and those of the objectors and their witness, the Sub Committee granted the amended application for a premises licence in the following terms and subject to the following Conditions:-

To permit the following:

- a. The performance of plays, exhibition of films and indoor sporting events, the playing of live and recorded music, the performance of dance and anything of a similar description Monday to Thursday from 08.00 to 00.00 and on Fridays and Saturdays from 08.00 to 00.30. On six occasional days per year the above is permitted from 08.00 to 02.00 as limited by Condition 2, below.
- b. The supply of alcohol Monday to Thursday from 08.00 to 23.30 and on Friday and Saturday from 08.00 to 00.00. On six occasional days per year the above is permitted from 08.00 to 02.00.
- c. The supply of late night refreshment Monday to Thursday from 23.00 to 00.00 and on Fridays and Saturdays from 23.00 to 00.30. On six occasional days per year the above is permitted from 08.00 to 02.00.

The licence is to be subject to the following Conditions:

1. That the Premises Licence Holder shall adopt and adhere to the "Challenge 21" protocol (seeking identification from everyone who appears to be under 21, to prove they are 18 or over prior to the sale of alcohol).
2. That there shall be no noise nuisance audible at the nearest residential boundary after 00.00 Sunday to Thursday and after 00.30 Friday and Saturday.
3. That the Halfway House is to close no later than one hour after sunset.

The provisions of the Operating Schedule as amended at the hearing shall apply as Conditions.
