

STREET NAMING AND NUMBERING CHARGES FROM 1st APRIL 2021

The *allocation* of a new name or number is free of charge. Once the number/name has been allocated, there is a charge to notify statutory undertakers and other interested parties, such as Royal Mail and emergency services. Notification will also include other statutory undertakers and internal departments of the Council such as Council Tax/Non Domestic Rates, Elections and Waste Management.

When multiple Plots are mentioned, please note that the fee is a *total* price for the number of plots and not the fee for *individual* plots within that range.

Adding/removal or amendment of a house/business name	£110 per property	Formal notification for changes to relevant statutory undertakers (Royal Mail, emergency services etc.)
Re-issue of an official naming or numbering statement	£28	Notification previously issued by the Council and sent to relevant statutory undertakers (Royal Mail, emergency services etc.)
Changing an existing street name	Individually charged dependent on necessary workload and associated costs	Consultation with all residents/owners within the street is required, with the majority being in favour of the change.
