

Introduction

The Three Rivers Safeguarding and Managing Crime Plan 2021-2024 is intended to provide an overview and summary of the work being undertaken by the Community Safety Partnership (CSP) towards tackling the six identified priorities outside of what is regarded daily business. The document has been shaped by the CSP Strategic Assessment incorporating the risk assessment. The priorities are not exclusively based on those findings and incorporates local thoughts and concerns and have accounted for challenges posed through the pandemic recovery.

The plan indicates through specified actions and objectives how the CSP will address the six priority areas of work. All Priorities listed are areas that need focus and attention in 2021-2024.

The priorities are:

1. Serious Violence and Exploitation.
2. Domestic Abuse
3. Exploitation Prevention
4. Motor Vehicle Crime
5. Burglary and Fraud
6. Hate Crime and Prevent

The engagement, commitment and support from all members of the Community Safety Partnership will be critical to the success of this work and enhancing our understanding of Three Rivers District. The same is also true of partners at all levels including the Anti-Social Behaviour Action Group (ASBAG), and Domestic Abuse Safeguarding Group, and South West Herts Youth Action Panel.

The management of the document is intended to be flexible to allow changes made in line with evolving threats and risks, throughout the time period of the action plan. The action plan is a “live” document that will be monitored and regularly updated by the Community Safety Coordinating Group, who will then report progress and challenges to Community Safety Board for Strategic Management. Objectives will be RAG rated in relation to their progress, definitions of the RAG rating can be seen in the table below.
