Hi Freddie,

A resident has raised a query in relation to the 'Predicted Traffic Flows' table (page 17) of the Cole and Jarman Planning Noise Assessment and I would be grateful for your clarification.

Query:

This report description seems to indicate that each 'count' in the report represents both an ingress and egress of a vehicle.

And so it represents the entirety of a vehicle interaction with the warehouse site - both the journey in and the journey out.

For example, between 0000-0100 there will be 6 HGV's going into the warehouse site of which 3 HGV's will visit unit 1 and

3 HGV's will visit unit 2 and they will then leave the site.

If we counted the ingress and egress of the HGV's as distinct and separate vehicle movements from each other, then we would

have to multiply the whole of this table by 2.

And so that would indicate, for example, 12 HGV 'trips/distinct vehicle movements between 0000-0100 made by these 6 HGV's
