Topic 21/0573/FUL – plan to build 24/7 warehouse complex immediately adjacent to where we live

We the undersigned are writing to notify you that we would regard a decision to grant permission to build a warehouse complex immediately adjacent to our family homes as a breach of the Human Rights Act (Article 8, 1&2 and Part II. The First Protocol/ Article 1) and are requesting that- on this basis - you should dismiss this proposal.

This development (during both the construction phase and when the warehouses are operational on a 24/7 basis) will have the following impact on our lives;

1. Noise from the development will disturb our sleep, with a highly negative impact on our children who require uninterrupted sleep, in order to be able to properly develop and thrive. It will inhibit the ability of residents to get a restorative night's sleep in order to work and to be productive in society. Noise from the development will prevent residents from opening their windows at night to keep cool during the summer months.
2. Noise disturbance will result in the loss of our family homes as refuge, inhibit our ability to be able to enjoy the benefit, comfort and safety of our own homes without risk to our mental and physical wellbeing.
3. Noise disturbance will inhibit our ability to be able to entertain family and friends in our homes, resulting in the diminution of our family and social lives.
4. Noise disturbance will inhibit our ability to be able to work from home.
5. It will place our families and friends in danger through the proximity of many HGV's and large vans very close to where we live and where children go to school. There is nothing to stop

commercial vehicles from the development using Maple Lodge Close and this is our only route out of Longmore Close.

The economic benefit of this proposal does not outweigh the personal destruction to me and my family in the context of the relevant articles of the Human Rights Act.
